


Romans 9:2 that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.

Romans 9:8 That is, those who *are* the children of the flesh, these *are not* the children of God; but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.

Romans 9:9 For this *is* the word of promise: “At this time I will come and Sarah shall have a son.”

**Romans 9:10 And not only *this*, but when
Rebecca also had conceived by one man,
even by our father Isaac**

Romans 9:11 (for *the children* not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works but of Him who calls),

Romans 9:12 it was said to her, “The older shall serve the younger.”

Romans 9:13 As it is written, “Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated.”

Genesis 25:22 But the children struggled together within her; and she said, “If *all is well, why am I like this?*” So she went to inquire of the LORD.


**Genesis 25:23 And the LORD said to her:

Hebrews 12:15 looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;


**Hebrews 12:16 lest there *be* any

Mal 1:1 The burden of the word of the Lord to Israel by Malachi.

Mal 1:2 “I have loved you,” says the Lord. “Yet you say, ‘In what way have You loved us?’ Was not Esau Jacob’s brother?” Says the Lord. “Yet Jacob I have loved;

Mal 1:3 But Esau I have hated, And laid waste his mountains and his heritage For the jackals of the wilderness.”

Mal 1:4 Even though Edom has said, “We have been impoverished, But we will return and build the desolate places,” Thus says the Lord of hosts: “They may build, but I will throw down; They shall be called the Territory of Wickedness, And the people against whom the Lord will have indignation forever.

Mal 1:5 Your eyes shall see, And you shall say, ‘The Lord is magnified beyond the border of Israel.’

Claim: God's love for Israel (אֶחָד (*āhēb*)

The priests despise God's name:

בָּזָה [bazah] “to despise, disdain, hold in contempt.”

**Malachi 1:6 “A son honors *his* father,
And a servant *his* master. If then I am the
Father, Where *is* My honor? And if I *am* a
Master, Where *is* My reverence? Says the
LORD of hosts To you priests who
despise My name. Yet you say, ‘In what
way have we despised Your name?’**

**Malachi 2:10 Have we not all one Father?
Has not one God created us? Why do we
deal treacherously with one another By
profaning the covenant of the fathers?**

Malachi 2:17 You have wearied the LORD with your words; Yet you say, “In what way have we wearied *Him*?” In that you say, “Everyone who does evil *Is* good in the sight of the LORD, And He delights in them,” Or, “Where *is* the God of justice?”

**Malachi 3:7 “Yet from the days of your fathers You have gone away from My ordinances And have not kept *them*.
Return to Me, and I will return to you,”
Says the LORD of hosts. “But you said,
‘In what way shall we return?’”**

Malachi 3:8 “Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, ‘In what way have we robbed You?’ In tithes and offerings.”

Malachi 3:13 “Your words have been harsh against Me,” Says the LORD, “Yet you say, ‘What have we spoken against You?”

Exodus 33:19 Then He said, “I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.”

Genesis 25:24 So when her days were fulfilled *for her* to give birth, indeed *there were* twins in her womb.

**Genesis 25:25 And the first came out red.
*He was like a hairy garment all over; so
they called his name Esau.***

Genesis 25:26 Afterward his brother came out, and his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them.
