fairness.**

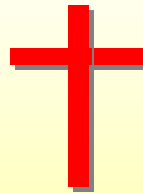

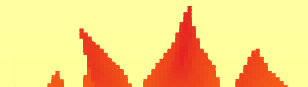

Zechariah 3:6, “Then the Angel of the LORD admonished Joshua, saying,”

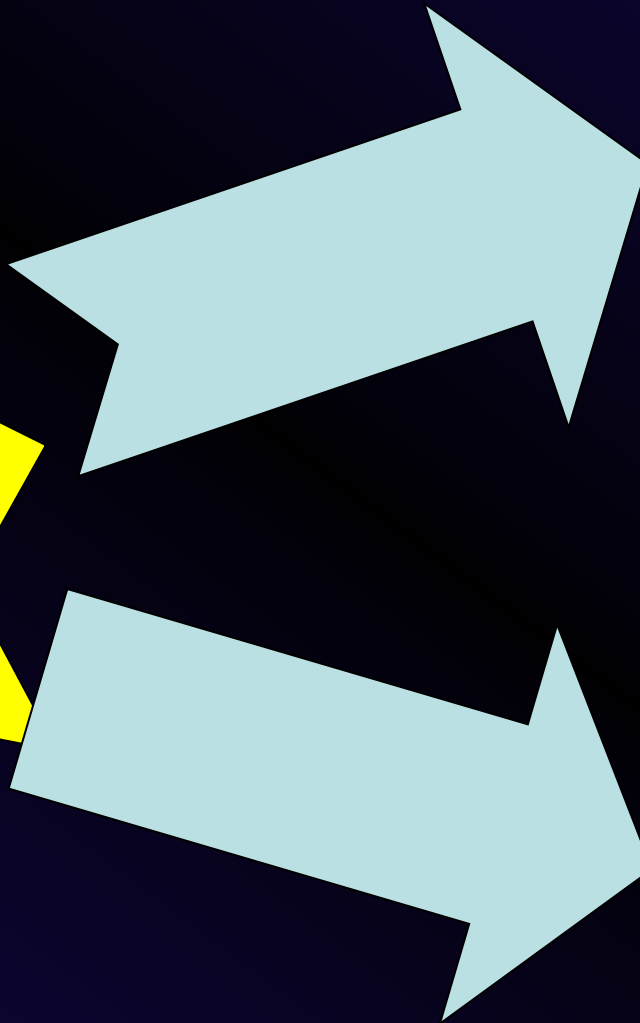
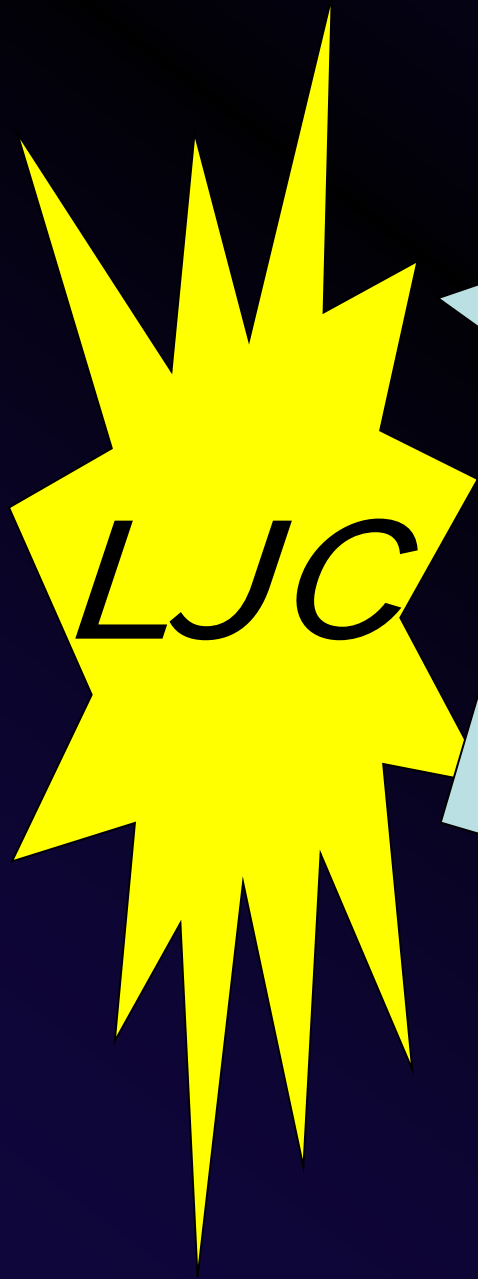
