First Seal–Conquest

- Rider with a bow
- Crown (στέφανος, *stephanos*) “victor’s wreath”
- Went out conquering and to conquer
- Personification of the Antichrist’s conquests







Rev. 6:7, “When the Lamb broke the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, ‘Come.’

Rev. 6:8, “I looked, and behold, an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.”

Eze. 5:15–17, “So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment, unto the nations that are round about thee, when I shall execute judgments on thee in anger and in wrath, and in wrathful rebukes; (I, YHWH, have spoken it;) when I shall send upon them the evil arrows of **famine, that are for destruction, which I will send to destroy you: and I will increase the **famine** upon you, and will break your staff of bread; and I will send upon you **famine** and **evil beasts**, and they shall bereave thee; and **pestilence** and blood shall pass through thee; and I will bring the **sword** upon thee: I, YHWH, have spoken it.”**

ἔχω (*echō*), have;

Imperfect, active, indicative

Imperfect=continuous action, past time.

“because of the witness they continually had”
