πειράζω, pi-rad'-zo;

“to test (objectively), put to the test, scrutinize, assay, examine, go about, prove, tempt(-er), try”

To put something to the test to reveal its essential nature or characteristics, to find out what something is made from.

“EARTH-DWELLER’S” RESPONSE

Rev. 6:15, “And the kings of the earth and the great men and the commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man, hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains;

Rev. 6:16, “and they said to the mountains and to the rocks, ‘Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the **wrath** of the Lamb; for the great day of their wrath has come; and who is able to stand?’”

Ex. 4:21, “The LORD said to Moses, ‘When you go back to Egypt see that you perform before Pharaoh all the wonders which I have put in your power; but I will **harden his heart** so that he will not let the people go.’”

Ex. 7:3, “But I will **harden Pharaoh’s heart** that I may multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt.”

חָזַק (*chazaq*), *piel*. “strengthen, fortify, reinforce”

קָשָׁה (*qāšâ I*), *hi*. “make hard, heavy.”

Rom. 1:18, “For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,”

Rom 1:21, “For even though they knew God, **they did not honor** Him as God or **give thanks**, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Rom 1:22, “Professing to be wise, they became fools,

Rom 1:23, “and **exchanged** the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.”
