




Rev. 12:6, “Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for one thousand two hundred and sixty days.”

Matt. 24:18, “And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes.


Matt. 24:19, “But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days!”

Rev. 12:9, “And the **great dragon** was thrown down, the **serpent** of old

who is called the **devil** and **Satan**, who **deceives** the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.”

Rev. 12:10, “Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, ‘Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser [*kategor*] of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses [*kategoron=satan*] them before our God day and night.’

Rev. 12:13, “And when the dragon saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male child.”

Jer. 30:7, “Alas! For **that day is great, so that none is like it; and it is the **time of Jacob’s trouble**, but he shall be saved out of it.”**



Rev. 12:15, “So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood.


Rev. 12:16, “But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth.”

- 8 Victory Ascent Upon the Mount of Olives





Sphere of Hyksos control in Egypt

Third Dynasty of Ur and the King Ur-Namma







- 5 “You will flee by my mountain valley, for it will extend to Azel. You will flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the LORD my God will come, and all the holy ones with Him.”
