

The Lampstand: Christ the Light of the World





Ex. 26:36, "You shall make a screen for the doorway of the tent of blue and purple and scarlet material and fine twisted linen, the work of a weaver.

Ex. 26:37, "You shall make five pillars of acacia for the screen and overlay them with gold, their hooks also being of gold; and you shall cast five sockets of bronze for them." Ex. 27:20, "You shall charge the sons of Israel, that they bring you clear oil of beaten olives for the light, to make a lamp burn continually." Lev. 24:2, "Command the sons of Israel that they bring to you clear oil from beaten olives for the light, to make a lamp burn continually." 1 Sam. 3:3, "and the lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the LORD where the ark of God was," Ex. 25:31, "Then you shall make a lampstand of pure gold. The lampstand and its base and its shaft are to be made of hammered work; its cups, its bulbs and its flowers shall be of one piece with it." John 1:4, "In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.

John 1:5, "The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it."

John 1:7, "He came as a witness, to testify about the Light, so that all might believe through him."

John 1:8, "He was not the Light, but he came to testify about the Light.

John 1:9, "There was the true Light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man."

John 3:19, "This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

John 3:20, "For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.

John 3:21, "But he who practices the truth comes to the Light, so that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God." John 8:12, "Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, 'I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life." Is. 9:1, "But there will be no more gloom for her who was in anguish; in earlier times He treated the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali with contempt, but later on He shall make it glorious, by the way of the sea, on the other side of Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles.

Is. 9:2, "The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them."

Is. 49:6 He says, "It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also make You a light of the nations so that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth." Eph. 5:8, "for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light."
