

## **Six Affirmations of Confidence**

- 1. *Yhwh* My Shepherd**
- 2. I have no lack, I need nothing, I have no needs**
- 3. He makes me lie down in green pastures**
- 4. He leads me beside the still water**
- 5. He restores my soul**
- 6. He guides me in the path of +R for his name sake**

***ḥāsēr***: A verb indicating to be lacking, to be needy; to decrease. In general, it refers to a failure of something to be fully complete, whole, sufficient (Ex. 16:18).

**Exo 16:18, “When they measured it with an omer, he who had gathered much had no excess, and he who had gathered little had no lack; every man gathered as much as he should eat.”**

*rābaṣ:*

“to lie down, to rest; to lay something down”

***nāhal:***

**“to lead, to guide, to move along.”**

***šûb:***

**“to turn, to return, to go back, to do again, to change, to withdraw, to bring back, to reestablish, to be returned, to bring back, to take, to restore, to recompense, to answer, to hinder.”**

***nāḥāh:***

**“to lead, to guide, usually in the right direction  
or on the proper path.”**

**Ps 31:3, “For You are my rock and my fortress;  
for Your name’s sake You will lead me and  
guide me.”**



*ma ʿgāl*

**“encampment, circle of a camp (1 Sam. 17:20; 26:5, 7) the trails animals make encircling the hills.”**
