έξουσία *exousia*Noun nom fem sing "authority, power; tribunate"



John 19:10, "Then Pilate said to Him, 'Are You not speaking to me? Do You not know that I have power to crucify You, and power to release You?'

John 19:11, "Jesus answered, 'You could have no <u>power</u> at all against Me unless it had been given you from above. Therefore the one who delivered Me to you has the greater sin.'"

Romans 13:1, "Let every soul be subject (ὑποτασσέσθω) to the governing authorities …"

Romans 13:4, "for he [a governing authority] is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil.

Romans 13:5, "Therefore you must be subject (ὑποτάσσεσθαι), not only because of wrath but also for conscience sake."
