

Position	Definition	Proponents
Complete continuity	Regen & indwell same	Owen, Fuller, Kaiser, Warfield, Wood
More continuity than discontinuity	Superficial differences in regen & indwelling	Augustine, Calvin, Grudem, Ladd
Some continuity; some discontinuity	Regen, but no indwell	Erickson, Packer, VanGemeren, Ware
More discontinuity than continuity	Operated on by God (Holy Spirit), no indwell	Novatian, Luther, Chafer, Blaising & Bock, Green
Discontinuity	Holy Spirit had nothing to do with OT saints	No representatives found
Vague discontinuity	Indwell denied, but regen not discussed	Origen, Tertullian, Chrysostom, Barrett, Ryrie, Walvoord

Economic Trinity

"Communication Model"

Father → Son → Holy Spirit

Speaker → Message → Effect

Inferences:

- 1. Spirit involved in every area of revelation
- 2. Spirit always causes effects "in" recipients without implying "indwelling"
- 3. Changes in the Son/Message → changes in the Spirit's activity



Covenant = Contract




- 1. Divine condescension

Heart Circumcision

"Circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and be stiff-necked no longer" (Deut. 10:16)



"The moral problem posed by the failure of the Mosaic Covenant will under the New Covenant be met by God's own sovereign grace and power. . . the benefits of the Mosaic Covenant will be attained, and at the same time its moral requirements will be secured. . . . The New Covenant, therefore, is in the gracious spirit of the earlier Abrahamic Covenant. . . . [It] is not on the basis of any surviving rights in the broken Covenant of Sinai but simply because Jehovah remembers His earlier 'covenant with Jacob, ...with Isaac, andwith Abraham' (Lev. 26:42)."

"indwelling" concept

What is "Indwelling" in OT?

Is Not = **Omnipresence**

Is Not = Redemptive action in individuals

Is = Localization of God's Presence in Tabernacle & Temple where copies of the contract were kept

Doxological Function	Redemptive/Sanctifying Function
Revelation of God's Nature	Carrying out protocols of Mosaic contract to provide a place of contact & to restrain sin

New Covenant Questions:

Jer 31:33 "I will write my law on their hearts" =?= previous heart circumcision

"The Torah will no longer reside in the ark in the temple. Yahweh promises that the Torah will have a new medium—no longer written on tablets but on hearts, and a new home—no longer residing in the ark in the temple but in God's people..."

New Covenant Questions:

Ezk 36:27 "I will put my Spirit within you" =?= previous heart circumcision

beqirbekem—translated in the NKJV as "within you"

"[This term] have been understood against the vision of God's glory leaving the temple in Ezekiel 8-11. Not only does this interpretation fit contextually, it also has grammatical probability on its side. Each time this term, which is the equivalent of 'in the midst of you all,' occurs in the Old Testament, it signifies something that is in the midst of the community collectively rather than something that is in the midst of each individual in the community. It would be remarkable if the uses of the form in Ezek. 36:26 and 27 were the lone exceptions to this pattern of usage in the Old Testament."

OT Positional Sanctification

Description	OT qualification
Justification	Basis of inclusion in the Abrahamic contract BUT promised +R not yet existing; Incarnation neither known nor existing; tension between Yahweh' holiness & personal sin
Regeneration	"Spiritual circumcision" = capacity to obey Yahweh (Holy Spirit enablement) BUT eternal life not yet existing in humanity; resurrection & union with Gentiles in same Body neither known nor existing

OT Experiential Sanctification

Description	OT qualification
Indwelling	Only texts addressing individual indwelling show it was limited as to people and as to duration. Major Indwelling in the tabernacle/temple for being among the people
Lordship justice	Administration (from the Indwelling location) of Mosaic contract behavior requirements: implications for national <i>corporate</i> life of the 10 commandments

Contrast with NT Sanctification

OT theocracy	NT Church age
Abrahamic Contract basis	Abraham's Messianic Seed basis
Spirit-enablement of the circumcised heart	Spirit-enablement of the regenerate heart
 Temporary Spirit indwelling in some key people for theocratic duties; Belonged to Yahweh's reign "among" the people from "in" the Tabernacle/Temple; Tabernacle/Temple = point of contact between God and mankind. 	 Permanent Spirit indwelling in all believers; Sum total of indwelt believers new Temple of the God who is "among" all mankind from being "in" every believer; Church = point of contact between God and mankind.
