The Evil of Religion Matthew 26:1–5

Matt. 26:13, "Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a memorial to her."

Rom. 5:6, "For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

Rom. 5:7, "For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.

Rom. 5:8, "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

1 Cor. 15:3, "For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,"

1 Cor. 1:23, "but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,"

1 Cor. 2:2, "For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified."

1 Pet. 2:24, "who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed."

1 Pet. 3:18, "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,"

Matt. 26:1, "Now it came to pass, when Jesus had finished all these sayings, that He said to His disciples,

Matt. 26:2, "'You know that after two days is the Passover, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified.'"

Matt. 16:21, "From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day."

Matt. 17:22, "Now while they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, 'The Son of Man is about to be <u>betrayed</u> into the hands of men,' "

Matt. 20:18–19, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be <u>betrayed</u> to the chief priests and to the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death, and <u>deliver</u> Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to crucify. And the third day He will rise again."

Acts 2:23, "Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;"


John 10:18, "No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."


