Introductory Comments on Worship and Music

1. It is not about old vs. new; traditional or contemporary, it is about fulfilling biblical principles for worship and music.

Popular Fallacies Related to the Worship Wars

- 1. It is not about the beat.
- 2. It is not about syncopation.
- 3. It is not about how fast.
- 4. It is not about when it was written.
- 5. It is not about the theological associations of the writer.
- 6. It is not about how it makes me feel.
- 7. It is not about which instruments are used.
- 8. It is not about personal taste.

Popular Fallacies Related to the Worship Wars

- 9. It IS about the worldview of the music.
- 10. It IS about the content of the lyrics.
- 11. It IS about the beauty and aesthetics of the song.
- 12. It IS about the correct form for expressing the content.
- 13. It IS about glorifying God through utilizing our very best creativity to produce art that reflects our Creator.

"Today we have a generation that not only thinks it is preferable to only sing songs written by their generation, but that they must only sing songs written by their generation.

Indeed, when people talk about 'contemporary' music, they are not, in fact, referring to the date of composition. The people who promote contemporary music, for instance, are not promoting the hymns of a twentieth-century hymn-writer such as E. Margaret Clarkson (b. 1915; d. 2008), whose hymns, though recently written, do not sound as though they were recently written. Nor are they promoting the fourteen hymns cowritten by the late James Montgomery Boice (d. 2000) and Paul S. Jones."

David Wells, Distinguished Research Professor at Gordon Conwell Seminary, analyzed several contemporary chorus books and traditional hymn books (several hundred choruses).

Almost 65% of all choruses had no doctrinal development or content.

Almost impossible to find a hymn with no doctrinal development or content.

(His study did not focus on the accuracy of the doctrine, only the presence of doctrinal development)

2. It is not only about the words, music as music matters.

3. The fallacy of the "new song"

Psa. 33:3, "Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy."

Psa. 40:3, "He has put a new song in my mouth—Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, and will trust in the LORD."

Psa. 96:1, "Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! Sing to the LORD, all the earth."

4. Everything in God's creation should emphasize His centrality, significance, and importance (i.e., "glory")

5. Suggested Standards:

- 1. The right question is not, "Is there something wrong with this music?", but "Does this music bring glory to God?"
- 2. Does this song reflect the creative acts of God?

Planning, orderly, technically excellent, promote positive morality, purposeful.

Does it display simplicity and complexity (unity and harmony)?
