



**His Will** 

"To him [Paul], preappointment [proorismos] is not the beginning of calling and justification, for if this was the beginning of the order and since those who were subtly introducing persuasive arguments are using absurd reasoning concerning salvation's origin, indeed, foreknowledge comes before preappointment [proorismos]."

No one was chosen. They are "choice" because they are dressed in imputed righteousness.
