# Examples of Harsh Language in the Book of Revelation

2:16 – "Repent therefore; or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with the sword of My mouth" (letter to Pergamum)

2:22-23a – "Behold, I will cast her upon a bed of sickness and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds. And I will kill her children with pestilence..." (letter to Thyatira)

# Examples of Harsh Language in the Book of Revelation

#### 7 Seals, 7 Trumpets, 7 Bowls

6:8 – And I looked, and behold, and ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name "Death"; and Hades was following with him. And authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, TO KILL WITH SWORD AND WITH FAMINE AND WITH PESTILENCE AND BY THE WILD BEASTS OF THE EARTH" (Fourth Seal)

# Harsh Trumpet Judgments

8:11b

...and a third of the waters became wormwood; and many men died from the waters, because they were made bitter (3<sup>rd</sup> trumpet)

#### 9:6

And in those days men will seek death and will not find it; and they will long to die and death flees from them. 9:10

And they have tails like scorpions, and stings; and in their tails is the power to hurt men for five months. (5<sup>th</sup> trumpet)

# **Harsh Trumpet Judgments**

#### 9:15

And the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and the day and month and year, were released, so that they might kill a third of mankind.

#### 9:18

A third of mankind was killed by these three plagues, by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone, which proceeded out of their mouths. (6<sup>th</sup> trumpet)
