

### Timeline of Abraham's life







**DESCENDANTS:** through the promised son (Isaac, then Jacob)





### **3.** The Signing of the Abrahamic Covenant

Two types of Covenants in the Bible

A <u>conditional or bilateral</u> (two-way) covenant is an have responsibilities or obligations to fulfill. The covenant with Moses was also temporary.

An <u>unconditional or unilateral covenant (one-way)</u> is an agreement between two parties but only one party has responsibilities to fulfill. The other party doesn't need to do anything.

<u>Gen. 15:9</u>, "So He said to him, 'Bring Me a three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old female goat, a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon.'


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
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

In Hebrew, there is no special word for "rainbow". It is simply "bow" (gesheth), the same word as in the weapon of war for firing arrows. So visually, God placed a bow pointing upwards toward Himself! The arrow, so to speak, was targeted at God Himself. It appears as if God placed Himself under a curse if He failed to keep away another global flood.





<u>Gen. 17:11, " 'and you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your</u> foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between Me and you. <u>Gen. 17:12, " 'He who is eight days old among you shall be circumcised.</u> every male child in your generations, he who is born in your house or bought with money from any foreigner who is not your descendant. Gen. 17:13, " 'He who is born in your house and he who is bought with your money must be circumcised, and My covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant. Gen. 17:14, " 'And the uncircumcised male child, who is not circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin, that person shall be cut off from his people; he has broken My covenant.'"

Physical circumcision: Outward sign of God's Covenant with Israel








# 2. YHWH sovereignly chose Abraham out of everyone alive at that time.


# Man's Ways
