



I. Glorification of Our Bodies




I. Glorification of Our Bodies



Lev. 19:28, "You shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor tattoo any marks on you: I am the LORD."

Stage 1: Believers are initially unable to experience God's glory properly.



Ezek. 1:28, "Like the appearance of a rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.

So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking."

Isa. 6:1, "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

Isa. 6:2, "Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.


Isa. 6:3, "And one cried to another and said: 'Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!'

Isa. 6:4, "And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.

Isa. 6:5, "So I said: 'Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.'"

<u>Luke 5:8</u>, "When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, '<u>Depart from me, for I am a sinful man</u>, O Lord!'

Stage 2: As the Holy Spirit works in believers, we begin to see God's glory.



- 2 Cor. 3:16, "Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.
- 2 Cor. 3:17, "Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- 2 Cor. 3:18, "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord."

At Mount Sinai



Moses' face reflected
God's glory, but it faded

Mosaic Law led to death: an external law cannot change hearts

Since the Cross




Holy Spirit gives life: He changes hearts and helps us see God's glory

- <u>2 Cor. 3:7</u>, "But if the ministry of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which glory was passing away,
- 2 Cor. 3:8, "how will the ministry of the Spirit not be more glorious?
- 2 Cor. 3:9, "For if the ministry of condemnation had glory, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much more in glory.
- 2 Cor. 3:10, "For even what was made glorious had no glory in this respect, because of the glory that excels.
- 2 Cor. 3:11, "For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious."

Stage 3: When God gives us our resurrection bodies, we will see His glory clearly.

Php. 3:20, "For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, Php. 3:21, "who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself."



- 2 Cor. 4:14, "knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you.
- 2 Cor. 4:15, "For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, <u>may cause thanksgiving</u> to abound to the glory of God."



- (c) Final proof: Glorification
 Our glorified resurrection
 body is the final proof that:
 - (a) God justified us and
 - (b) He has completed our sanctification.

Rom. 8:18, "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Rom. 8:19, "For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God."

Rom. 8:23, "Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.

Rom. 8:24, "For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

Rom. 8:25, "But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance."




Glorification of Man

Man sees God's glory clearly and reflects it!

Rom. 5:2, "through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and <u>rejoice in hope of the glory of God</u>."

- 2 Cor. 4:16, "Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.
- 2 Cor. 4:17, "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory,
- 2 Cor. 4:18, "while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal."










When will we get our glorified bodies?



- 1 Cor. 15:51, "Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—
- 1 Cor. 15:52, "in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 1 Cor. 15:53, "For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality."



II. Glorification of creation

Rom. 8:20, "For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope;

Rom. 8:21, "because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Rom. 8:22, "For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now."











Phase 1

Isa. 55:12, "For you shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; The mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

<u>Isa. 55:13</u>, "Instead of the thorn shall come up the cypress tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree; <u>And it shall be to the LORD for a name</u>, for <u>an everlasting</u> <u>sign that shall not be cut off</u>."

Phase 2

Psa. 102:25, "Of old You laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands.

Psa. 102:26, "They will perish, but You will endure; Yes, they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will change them, and they will be changed."


Rev. 21:1, "Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea.


Rev. 21:2, "Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Titus 2:11, "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,


<u>Titus 2:12</u>, "teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,
